HealthFirst Family Care Center recognizes the epidemic of opioid and alcohol addiction as a major challenge to the health of our community especially during the COVID pandemic. We are proud of the work that our Opioid & Alcohol Recovery Program (OAR) has been doing in working with our community at large.

OAR is an integrated model of medication assisted treatment (MAT). MAT is the use of Suboxone or Vivitrol in the treatment of one's opioid/alcohol addiction. HealthFirst integrates addiction treatment along with psychiatric, primary care and behavioral health services.

Our highly experienced team of specialized medical providers and behavioral health staff ensure one's sustainable recovery through the individualized use of MAT, psychiatry, individual & group counseling, family support and navigation of the community services.

Treatment staff includes a certified doctor in substance use disorders, RN Care Manager and Clinical Social Workers. All insurances accepted.
